FRANCHISE AGREEMENT

This Franchise Agreement (“Agreement”) is made on this ___ day of ___, 20, at _____

BETWEEN

The National Board of Vocational Training (NBVT), having its registered office at **KIADB Complex, Humnabad Road, Vidya Nagar, Kapnoor, Tq. Dist. Kalaburagi** (hereinafter referred to as the “Board” or “Franchisor”),

_____ (hereinafter referred to as the “Franchisee”).

The Board and the Franchisee are hereinafter collectively referred to as the “Parties” and individually as a “Party.”

1. Grant of Franchise Rights

1.1 The Board hereby grants the Franchisee the right to establish and operate a **Vocational Training Centre** under the name and authority of the **National Board of Vocational Training (NBVT)**.

1.2 The Franchisee shall operate exclusively within the territory of _____

1.3 The Franchisee shall not use the NBVT brand or logo except in accordance with the guidelines provided by the Board.

2. Franchise Fees & Royalty

2.1 The Franchisee agrees to pay a one-time **Franchise Fee** of Rs. _____ (non-refundable).

2.2 The Franchisee shall remit to the Board a **Royalty/Service Fee** of ___% of the gross revenue or Rs. _____ per student enrolled, whichever is higher.

2.3 All payments shall be made in advance as per the payment schedule issued by the Board.

3. Infrastructure & Standards

3.1 The Franchisee shall establish and maintain infrastructure (classrooms, labs, equipment, IT facilities, etc.) as per the **NBVT guidelines**.

3.2 The Franchisee shall ensure minimum prescribed area, staff, and facilities for conducting training programs.

3.3 The Franchisee shall allow periodic inspections by authorized representatives of the Board.

4. Training, Curriculum & Examination

4.1 The Board shall provide:

- Standardized course curriculum and syllabus.
- Study material, examination structure, and certification format.
- Faculty orientation and periodic training.

4.2 The Franchisee shall strictly adhere to the prescribed curriculum and conduct training as per NBVT norms.

4.3 All examinations shall be conducted under the supervision of the Board.

5. Duties & Responsibilities of Franchisee

- Ensure admission, attendance, and student data management in prescribed formats.
- Maintain transparency in fee collection and report the same to the Board.
- Employ qualified trainers approved/recognized by the Board.
- Not engage in parallel or competitive training under another brand.
- Promote NBVT programs ethically and in accordance with brand guidelines.

6. Intellectual Property

All logos, marks, training content, software, and digital platforms remain the exclusive property of NBVT. The Franchisee shall have only a limited right to use them during the term of this Agreement.

7. Term & Renewal

7.1 This Agreement is valid for ___ years from the date of execution.

7.2 Renewal shall be subject to satisfactory performance, compliance, and payment of renewal fee as prescribed by the Board.

8. Termination

The Board may terminate this Agreement in case of:

- Non-payment of fees/royalty.
- Breach of quality standards or operational guidelines.
- Misuse of NBVT name or credentials.
- Violation of government regulations.

Upon termination, the Franchisee shall immediately stop using the NBVT brand and return all materials.

9. Confidentiality

The Franchisee agrees to keep confidential all NBVT materials, strategies, examination data, and other proprietary information.

10. Dispute Resolution

Any disputes arising shall first be resolved through mutual discussion. If unresolved, disputes shall be referred to arbitration under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. Jurisdiction shall lie with the courts of _____.

11. Miscellaneous

- This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the Parties.
- Amendments shall only be valid if made in writing and signed by both Parties.
- Notices shall be delivered in writing to the registered addresses of both Parties.
